Approval of Monthly Reports:

Plant Operator Jeremy Davis presented an estimate of \$437.00 for a new residual chlorine meter reader which was needed to replace a reader at the Upper Well House. Motion by Hahn, seconded by Cohill to purchase the reader at this cost. Motion carried unanimously.

Kane advised he had followed up with CE Williams concerning past due property repair work that needed to be done at the site of the water leak repair from last fall on High Street. Kane sited uncooperative weather for part of the holdup for the repair.

Davis advised that he had been contacted by Negleys advising that starting in April, he would need to pull additional water samples to test chlorine levels. The additional testing is required by DEP to be taken at two alternating points on a weekly basis. The testing results would be submitted to Negleys who would forward the results to DEP.
