Zoning Map Change – 2015 Chambersburg Road and others – Sharrah Design Group, Inc.

Mr. Bob Sharrah, on behalf Paul Weikert requested a zoning change from Agricultural to Residential in this area. Supervisor Crushong informed Mr. Sharrah that the Planning Commission is in the process of looking at the Zoning and making changes but that it would not be done until the end of the year. Mr. Sharrah commented that they were hoping for a quicker response. There was discussion about going to the Zoning Hearing Board and ask for the change through the Board.

Amy/David Masenheimer and Joe Riddlemoser / Brightspeed Agreement and Road Occupancy

Ms. Amy Masenheimer spoke concerning Brightspeed wanting to run high speed internet along Tillietown Road to Graphcom on Silo Road. She informed the board that her family and others do not want poles on their properties and there are other options. Adam Cubbedge, representative from Brightspeed explained their intent to provide ethernet to Graphcom. There are options to bore and install a fiber pedestal underground. Mr. Cubbedge informed the Board that they are doing this in many areas and the fiber option is much faster and efficient. The Board decided to table the decision and would like to hear from residents along Tillietown Road concerning this issue.


