- 2408 Chambersburg Road Solar Facility Conditional Use
 - A representative for a Sol America presented a draft plan for a solar field array on an agricultural-zoned parcel at 2408 Chambersburg Road. The request is for a variance to allow a 34-foot setback from the road to the solar array instead of the 200-foot setback required by code.
 - The PC asked what hardship was created by the 200-foot setback requirement.
 The representative indicated that the setback would push the solar array deeper into the open field of the parcel and reduce the currently farmable area.
 - MOTION: The Planning Commission RECOMMENDS DISAPPROVAL of variance request for a setback, due to the insufficient demonstration or justification of a hardship caused by the Township code, by Gary Deardorff, seconded by Eric Miller.
