Board of Supervisors Workshop Meeting

The workshop, held at the Franklin Township Municipal Building, was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Supervisor Santay.

Kurt Fleshman

Mr. Fleshman was present to discuss the barn at 5940 Chambersburg Road. Mr. Fleshman informed the Board that he has a contract in to purchase the barn contingent upon the present Owner cleaning it out. Mr. Fleshman asked the Board what kind of time frame he would have to complete the renovations to the barn to make it presentable. The Board informed Mr. Fleshman that the Township would work with him in the completion of the work.

Dirt and Gravel Road Application – Newman Road

Susan Plank, Secretary/Treasurer informed the Board that Curt MacBeth, Roadmaster is planning to put DSA on Newman Road through a Dirt and Gravel Road Grant which needs to be signed. The work is planned for 2022.

Tree removal on Glenwood Road

Supervisor Santay informed everyone that he talked to Solicitor Yannetti and he informed everyone that Solicitor Yannetti and Clem Malot, PA Municipal Code Alliance are discussing what the next step should be for the removal of the trees. Supervisor Santay suggested to table until August 5, 2021 Board of Supervisors Meeting and everyone agreed.

American Rescue Plan Funding

Susan Plank, Secretary/Treasurer informed everyone that a separate account has been set up for the funds received and that PSATS sent an email saying that the use of the funds is still being determined and the Townships will not see anything on this until September.

Grader Stingers

Supervisor Santay informed everyone that Curt MacBeth, Roadmaster told him that Cumberland Township is going to purchase the stingers from the old grader for \$1,500.00 once it is voted on at their next meeting at the end of the month. Supervisor Santay informed everyone that Curt MacBeth, Roadmaster will picking the new grader up from Greene Township next Wednesday. The old grader can then be listed on Municibid. Susan Plank, Secretary/Treasurer informed the Board that she and Curt, Roadmaster was talking about sending an email blast out to the local Townships/Boroughs to see if anyone is interested in it. The Board agreed that this would be a good idea.

Liberty Township Letter Concerning Police Protection

The Board would like Susan Plank, Secretary/Treasurer to invite Ms. Hansen to the next Workshop to discuss specifics as to what can be offered and the cost of it.
