Franklin Township, Adams County Board of Supervisors Workshop Meeting July 18, 2019

SUPERVISORS PRESENT: Henry Crushong, Jr., Matt Williams, and Chris Santay via Skype.

The workshop, held at the Franklin Township Municipal Building, was called to order at 7:00 p.m. p.m. by Supervisor Crushong.

Knouse Fruitlands – Dog Dock Diving Events

Supervisor Crushong asked if Knouse Fruitlands had insurance coverage for these events. Susan Plank replied that they do until September and that they have listed the Township as additional insured. Supervisor Crushong also asked if a letter had been sent to Knouse Fruitlands concerning the violations. Susan Plank, Secretary/Treasurer informed everyone that Wilbur Slothour, Land and Sea Services, LLC. had sent a letter. Susan also mentioned that Knouse Fruitlands was invited to the next Board meeting in the letter and also Wilbur Slothour asked for a visit of the site with Knouse Fruitlands.

5 Newman Road and 400 Church Road

Supervisor Crushong asked about the status of 5 Newman Road and 400 Church Road. Susan Plank, Secretary/Treasurer informed everyone that Land and Sea Services is to issue another citation for 5 Newman Road but she did know what the status for 400 Church Road was. There was talk about what the Township can do to deter dumping in this area, (warning signs, etc.).
