August 4, 2022

CALL TO ORDER

PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS ONLY

There was no public comment.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

MOTION by Supervisor Williams, seconded by Supervisor Crushong to approve the July 7, 2022 Board of Supervisors Meeting Minutes and the July 21, 2022 Board of Supervisors Workshop Meeting Minutes. Motion carried, 3-0.

APPROVAL OF BILL LIST #8

MOTION by Supervisor Crushong, seconded by Supervisor Williams to approve Bill List #8 – General Account - \$61,406.72 Check Nos. 37794 – 37838, State Fund Account - \$117,199.16 Check Nos. 66358 – 6636, WW Museum Escrow Account - \$10,900.00 – Check No. 5, Fire Tax Fund - \$19207.20 – Check No. 5 for a total of \$208,713.08. Motion carried, 3-0.

PRELIMINARY/FINAL PLAN

Kalathas Mini Storage – Release of Bond – Brandon Guiher, KPI Technologies commented that they have inspected the site and KPI Technologies' recommends to release \$118,170.67 with a balance of \$12,552.40 which can be released once the fence along the back of the site is installed, preparation of as-built drawings, installation of R-3 rip rap around inlet boxes, installation of soil amendments, and installation of shrubs/trees.

Motion by Supervisor Williams, seconded by Supervisor Crushong to release \$118,170.67 of the Kalathas Security Bond leaving a balance of \$12,552.40 based on the recommendations from KPI Technologies. Motion carried, 3-0.

STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN

Allen – 760K Buchanan Valley Road

Maybury – 2475 Mummasburg Road

Brandon Guiher, KPI Technologies informed the Board that the two (2) Stormwater Management Plans listed were reviewed and approved.

Brandon Guiher, KPI Technologies also informed the Board that there was a hit for Bog Turtles at the Route 30 Culvert repair project but they are hoping that since the work is within the pipe there will be no issues.

Brandon Guiher, KPI Technologies mentioned to the Board that the WWII Museum is working on the signs, right turn only and no commercial buses at the intersection of Crooked Creek and Chambersburg Roads.

Supervisor Williams asked Brandon, KPI Technologies what was happening with the paving out to Chambersburg Road (Route 30) at the Store It project. Brandon informed the Board that he would look into it and update the Board with what they find out.

Resident David Garlach informed the Board that he has received his Highway Occupancy Permit and he will be having yard sales through October.


ADJOURN

MOTION by Supervisor Crushong, seconded by Supervisor Williams to adjourn the meeting at 7:26 pm.


