The meeting was called to order by Dennis Robinson at 7 pm.

Approval of April 2018 Planning Commission Minutes

MOTION by McDannell, seconded by Schindel to approve the April minutes. Motion carried.

Guests & Old Business:

Darrin Hartzell – sketch plan – Church Road – Residential Zone

Owns 3 lots. Lot 1 is 8.718 +/- acres, Lots 3 & 4 are 1.1 +/- acres each for a total of approximately 10.918 acres. He would like to put a loop road around and behind Lot 2 & A (which he does not own) and Lots 3 & 4 (which he does own). This would provide access to 6 new proposed lots on Lot 1 (8.718 +/- acres). It was noticed on his sketch plan, which was a copy of Paul T. Dean's deed dated 4/6/2006 a Note (#8) which states "Lot 1 is to be retained for agricultural uses and shall not be subsequently subdivided". At the time of this deed, this area was zoned agriculture, since then it has changed to a residential zone. We were unsure how this will impact his plans. We suggested he consult with a lawyer about whether there would be a problem doing subdivisions on the property that was once zoned Agricultural and has the note on the deed about no future subdivisions on Lot 1.

Donald Alcorn – sketch plan – Indian Acres Farm Management, Inc. – 1059 Belmont Road - Ag Zone His property is in Franklin and Butler Townships. He would like to build a winery at his location. No problems seen so we suggested he hire a consultant.

Kalathas Plan Update – They did go before the Zoning Hearing Board the previous evening. They will still have to meet some requirements and will need to bring the plan back for review.
