## Franklin Township, Adams County Board of Supervisors Special Meeting February 15, 2017

SUPERVISORS PRESENT: Jerry Arrison, JR Crushong, and Chris Santay

**OTHERS PRESENT:** Susan Plank, Secretary

The meeting, held at the Franklin Township Municipal Building, was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Henry Crushong, Jr.

Supervisor Crushong informed everyone that the reason for the Special Meeting is to award the Winding Road Project Contract. Supervisor Crushong informed everyone that the Township had given the bids to the Bernie Yannetti, Solicitor and KPI to sort through and to make sure that everything was in place. The bid process was also approved by Joshua Kopp, Township PennDot Rep. There were bids from Wilson Paving and Hammaker East, Ltd.

Wilson Paving's Bid - Shoulder Paver - \$85.00 per hour, Milling machine with 3' head and operator - \$310.00 per hour.

MOTION by Supervisor Arrison, seconded by Supervisor Santay to accept Wilson Paving's Bid – Shoulder Paver - \$85.00 per hour, Milling machine with 3' head and operator - \$310.00 per hour. Motion carried, 3-0.

Hammaker East, Ltd.'s Bid - LBM Oil - \$1.74 per gallon - \$140,940.00, Pug Mill - \$340.00 per hour, Tandem Vibratory 10-ton roller with operator - \$235.00 per hour, 24' Paver with operator and crew - \$595.00 per hour.

MOTION by Supervisor Arrison, seconded by Supervisor Santay to accept Hammaker East, Ltd.'s Bid – LMB Oil - \$1.74 per gallon total \$140,940.00, Pug Mill - \$340.00 per hour, Tandem Vibratory 10-ton roller with operator - \$235.00 per hour, 24' Paver with operator and crew - \$595.00 per hour. Motion carried, 3-0.

Wilbur Slothour, Land and Sea Services, Inc. informed the Board of Supervisors that Milton Knouse came to him and wanted to know if they could dig a ditch to run the electrical line into the Building from the pole. Wilbur informed the Board that it would be approximately 70' of laying a line from the Pole to the Building and that he would be completing the inspection. Supervisors gave the okay to dig the ditch for the electric line.

Supervisor Arrison informed Wilbur Slothour of Land and Sea Services about a mattress that was laying out on High Street and about a porch on Route 30 that looks like it is about to fall down. Wilbur informed the Board that they would look into both issues.

Supervisors asked Wilbur to have Tim McCauslin from Land and Sea to give Susan a weekly report as to what is going on and the progress of such complaints.

Larry and Joan Bushey wanted to know where the project was for Winding Road. Supervisor Crushong informed them that the project was running from Winding Road to Boyer Nursery Road. Mrs. Bushey wanted to know about a \$2,500.00 fee for Lot 7 Poplar Springs Road. Supervisors informed Ms. Bushey that it was a stand-alone Ordinance that was passed some time ago. Mr. Slothour informed Ms. Bushey that the cost was based on what District the property was in. Supervisor Crushong informed everyone that Traffic Impact Fees are part of most Townships and Boroughs with the exception of a few. It is something that he and the other Supervisors will review.

There being no further business to conduct, MOTION by Supervisor Santay and seconded by Supervisor Arrison to adjourn the meeting at 6:25 pm, Motion carried, 3-0.
