OLD BUSINESS

Brightspeed – No update

Ben King – Sawmill – 385 Ragged Edge Road

A violation has been issued for the accumulation of logs at this location. There was some discussion on the sawmill request. The owner was not present at the meeting. Mr. and Mrs. Glass had concerns about the sawmill and truck traffic on Ragged Edge Road. The Board of Supervisors informed Mr. and Mrs. Glass that Mr. King has the right to go before the Zoning Hearing Board and present their case for an exemption if they want to proceed that way. The adjoining property owners and other landowners has the right to voice their concerns. The Board of Supervisors would also have representation for their opinion on the sawmill. There was discussion about what can be done if the Board of Supervisors or residents do not agree with the Zoning Hearing Board decision. The Board of Supervisors would like Susan Plank, Secretary/Treasurer to call Solicitor Yannetti about and cease and desist order. Supervisor Williams questioned the Violation. Lisa Trimmer, Zoning Officer commented that there are truck loads of logs on the site which according to Zoning is a violation based on the piles of logs could lead to infestation on the property of rodents, vermin, and/or vectors.

NEW BUSINESS

Advertise for Fuel, Materials, Line Painting, Sealcoating, and the Road Project (Crooked Creek Road).

MOTION by Supervisor Crushong, seconded by Supervisor Williams to have Susan Plank, Secretary/Treasurer to advertise for Fuel, Materials, Line Painting, Sealcoating, and the Road Project (Crooked Creek Road) bids. Motion carried, 3-0.

Increase spending limit of Secretary/Treasurer and Roadmaster Members 1st Credit Union credit cards.

MOTION by Supervisor Williams, seconded by Supervisor Crushong to approve the Members 1st credit card limit to \$2,500.00 for Susan Plank, Secretary/Treasurer and Curtis MacBeth, Roadmaster for a total of \$5,000. Motion carried, 3-0.
