

**FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL AUTHORITY  
BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING  
February 3, 2026**

Present: Board Members- Dawn Williams, Darrin Flake, Dianna Moy, Robert Martin, Plant Operator, Jeremy Davis, Secretary/Treasurer-Debra Hahn.

The meeting held at the Franklin Township Municipal Building was called to order by Chairman Williams at 7:00 p.m.

**Approval of Monthly Reports:**

**Motion** by Moy seconded by Martin to approve January 6, 2026 Minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

**Motion** by Flake to add CE Williams invoice of \$3435.58 to the February 3, 2026, Bill List #1, bringing total to \$8,495.92. Motion to approve, seconded by Martin. Motion carried unanimously.

**Motion** by Flake, seconded by Martin to approve February 3, 2026 General Account Report. Motion carried unanimously.

Plant Operator Davis reported that a water leak had occurred on January 28 in Edwards Court. A resident heard the sound of rushing water and contacted Davis, who discovered the leak. C.E. Williams was contacted to find and repaired leak. Davis noted that restoration to yards and some cold patch would need to be done when weather permits.

Davis reported that he had recently been contacted by Pennsy Supply, advising plans were being made to repave all of High Street early spring. Davis said with the Authority's plan to extend the water main out High Street in the future, the time was now to move the water main under High Street to the other side. Davis stated Pennsy would work with the Authority in replacing the blacktop after the line was installed, which would be a cost savings to the Authority. He said he would be contacting C.E. Williams of their availability and cost to move the line. It was noted that depending on cost, the project would possibly need to put out on bid.

Davis also reported that he was contacted by two customers that had 'leaky' water meters in their basement. He stated that the leaks were minimal. He advised he didn't want to replace both meters now, if it could be held off until the meter pit project took place. He would be in contact C.E. Williams for an estimate of when they planned on started the project.

Davis said he had concerns about two water customer properties located at 1431 & 1465 Old Route 30. He said that years ago, all residents within the water service area were

forced to hookup to municipal water. He recently found out that both of these homes had to install water pumping systems due to no pressure from the water main. He said no other customer on the system has to pump their water. He was of the opinion that neither property should have been forced to hook up to the main if the main couldn't supply sufficient water pressure to the residence. Martin suggested that Negleys be contacted to check pressure at these two and neighboring properties down to High Street. Davis advised he would call Negleys to discuss.

Guest Dale Cline ask the Board who should be contacted in the event of a water emergency. He stated that the township website shows contacting the township. Davis stated that he should be contacted. Secretary Hahn advised she would contact the township secretary and have the site updated with updated emergency contact information.

Davis advised that he had concerns with the new meter pit project, what would happen if there was a deep snow and the meter reader could not locate the pit when time to read meter usage. He stated that currently the meter reader needs to be pointed at the top of the pit for the reading. Williams advised she thought that the grant project included pits that had a signal transmittal for the reading to be taken from the road. Davis said he would contact Engineer Dave Cunningham to confirm.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 pm
